

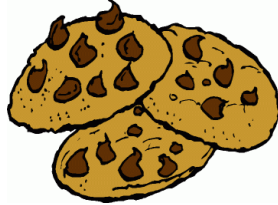
~ RULES ~

- ALL pies/cookies must be brought to the event at 6 pm. NO pies/cookies should be sent into school during the day and will not be accepted. Cookies entered will need to be at the very least 2 dozen.
- ALL grade students will compete together in the same contest.
- Students are allowed to receive help from their parents because our PTA wants this to be a fun activity for your family to do together.
- Any type of pie/cookies is allowed and all pies/cookies will be judged together in the same category. There will be one winner selected as Grand Champion, as well as 2nd and 3rd place prizes.
- Each pie/cookies will be assigned a number, so that judging is anonymous
- Judging is a "penny a vote" and everyone that attends our event can be a judge! There will be containers in front of each pie/cookie, and the winners will be determined by the most votes. You do not have to vote with only pennies. If you'd like to vote 25 times for a pie, simply put in a quarter.
- There will also be a Teacher Division that will be judged separately from the Student Division. All the same rules above apply.
- All entrants are responsible for their own dishes. Disposable pans are recommended. Do not bring pie servers, our PTA will provide all utensils.
- Please do not purchase a pre-made pie. This is supposed to be a fun activity for your children so enjoy the memories you're going to create! Even if you've never baked a pie/cookies before, now is the time to learn!

There are lots of recipes on line so have fun with this! All proceeds will go to the PTA to help fund activities for this school year.
