Many people who visit our church are coming from other faith traditions or denominations. We have developed four courses as an introduction to the CCDOC, our beliefs, and spiritual development. These courses are offered throughout the year and provide a basic introduction for those who want more detailed information.

Disciples 101 - is a brief survey of the history and beliefs of the Christian Church (DOC). **Mission 201** - is an introduction to the mission of this church, First Christian Church of Jonesboro, AR.

Faith 301 - is a survey of different methods of spiritual growth developed during over the history of the church. From the church Fathers in the 1st and 2nd Century to the monastic reforms of the Middle Ages.

Justice 401 - introduces the concept of Biblical justice, surveys the prophetic tradition as it relates to justice, and introduces current issues for consideration. The previous three courses (101, 201, and 301) and church membership are required prior to taking this course. Individuals interested in this material should be aware that it touches on some of the most controversial topics in church life, and no "official" answers will be provided (in true Disciple tradition) since there are no answers in many of these areas, only questions.

seminary or an equivalent program of study under a mentor. A commissioned minister is either a minister preparing for ordination, or a lay person who does not intend to seek ordination. FCC's Pastor, Bob Palmer, has an M.Div. from Memphis Theological Seminary and is an Ordained Disciples of Christ minister.
