Bizzy B's offers recycling services customized to fit your community needs. A partnership with Bizzy B's provides the ability to dispose of hard to recycle items. With an EPA HVAC certification, Bizzy B's meets the requirements to properly dispose of refrigerators, air conditioners and other items containing Freon. In addition, Bizzy B's takes items either not permitted, or discouraged in landfills including batteries, metal, and wire. We provide services that other communities in the U.S. have utilized to turn themselves into recycling leaders.* This establishes these cities and towns as being low waste, energy efficient, and cleaner communities.

Community Partnerships Programs

Community Services:

- **Clean-up Days:** We can provide roll-offs to dispose of metal, batteries and appliances during town sponsored clean-up days. We would provide employees to supervise the disposal process.
- **Freon Appliance Pick-ups:** If your community expresses a desire to collect older refrigerators as part of an XCEL Energy program, ECO-Cycle, or independently, we can schedule regular pick-ups of these appliances and provide the necessary documentation to demonstrate their proper disposal.
- **Purchases:** We can collect, weigh, and pay your city for items that are regularly or irregularly disposed of. In the past this has consisted primarily of wire from holiday lights, rewiring of city buildings, and remodels; however, we are available to pick up any items that we accept on our own site. Through this program, your city would be able to dispose of items and get paid for them.

Equipment: We have available to you roll-offs as well as dumpsters for the collection of recyclable materials.

- **Roll-Offs:** Size-30 yards. These can be used for clean-up days or any other large scale disposal events.
- **Dumpsters:** Size- 1 yard to 30 yard. These can be used on smaller disposal scales and can be left at designated sites and picked up at regularly scheduled times.

We accept the following items for recycling:

Copper, Steel, Aluminum, Brass, Wire, Lead, Batteries, Appliances, and Automobiles.

We do not accept the following items for recycling:

TV's, Monitors, Glass, and Plastic.

Hours: flexible for pick-ups and events, including Mondays.
