In November 2014, she was showcased in Bill Duke's book entitled, "Dark Girls" where she also wrote the afterword. Additionally, Dr. Jackson and her wife were featured in the JET Magazine's love section in August of 2011 making them only the second lesbian couple to be featured in the publication since its inception in 1951 and the first couple to be included in that particular section.

Dr. Jackson devotes a considerable amount of time volunteering in the community as a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., Los Angeles Alumnae Chapter as well as many other organizations.
