1. Meeting Called to Order - Vice - Chairman Gena Curtis Presiding

2. Roll Call and Determination of a Quorum

As per Article III, Section 8 of the Austin Cops for Charities bylaws, at any meeting of the Austin Cops for Charities Board of Trustees, a quorum shall require three of the seven board members present. There were four board members present at this meeting therefore a quorum was present.

3. Austin Cops for Charities Membership Drive

Austin Cops for Charities Membership Drive Coordinator Sgt. Mike Jones addressed the C4C Board on the membership drive and pledged to continue getting APD officers to join Austin Cops for Charities. As of Pay Period Ending 5/3/14 C4C Membership went from 670 to 724 (including 11 from 127th Cadet Class) bringing new total to 724 C4C Members (payroll deduction).

4. Ken Casaday to Address the C4C Board – Crabb Family Expense to Police Memorial in Washington D.C.

The Austin Police Association had approached C4C Chairman Gary Rosch about Austin Cops for Charities sharing the expense of sending the Crabb Family to Washington D.C. when Lt. Clay Crabb's name will be placed on the National Memorial Police wall of officers killed in the line of duty. APA has paid the total expense of \$4,445.00 and is requesting that C4C cover half which is \$2,222.50. Tonya Jefferson moved to assist the APA with the Crabb travel expense by reimbursing the APA \$2,222.50 for half of the cost. A second came from Ralph Wayne. Motion was voted on and passed.
