LinKS – Leaders in Knowledge & Support was launched by the Austin Police Department's Office of Community Liaison and the United States Army, III Corps Ft. Hood. The program exposes youth to other opportunities after high school if college is unaffordable. LinKS is designed to motivate, encourage and challenge high school students to excel above their peers, exceeding expectations while setting and reaching new personal goals. The program is also designed to develop more student leaders in the community by providing students with the effective tools and valuable community networks and leadership skills training.
